GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Under the supervision of the Clinical Supervisor or Clinical Director, the Children's Mental Health Therapist provides individual, family and group therapy for children who have experienced trauma and abuse and demonstrate need for more intensive therapeutic services.

DUTIES: Provision of individual, family and group therapy in accordance with the individual case plans of children participating in Tapestry's programs. Preparation of timely progress notes, completion of biopsychosocial assessments, diagnosis, treatment plans and case coordination services. Attendance to group and individual supervision, Child and Family Team Meetings, Staff meetings and department meetings.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must be registered with the BBS as a Licensed or Waivered Clinician (AMFT, ASW, LPCC, LMFT, LCSW). Must pass background check, demonstration of ability to provide essential functions, CPR/First Aid Certification & TB clearance. Must have valid CDL, cleared DMV record, computer skills, strong work ethic and demonstrated professional and compassionate interpersonal skills.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES: Experience providing therapeutic services for children and families. Experience working with a team to develop individual assessments of strengths and needs in the area of mental and emotional health, and to assess progress in these areas. Experience in organizing information and the writing of reports. Experience of the Child Welfare system and Foster Care.
